We also have a really high demand for our homes.

The table below provides you with information that shows just how long you may have to wait.

Size of house	No. on waiting list in February 2024	No. of houses let to waiting list applicants in 2023
1 bedroom	76	1
2 bedroom	188	1
3 bedroom	123	1
4 bedroom	41	0

This clearly shows that even applicants with a very high priority are likely to have to wait for a long time before we can offer them a house.

Because we have so many applicants and so few houses to let to applicants, we will only contact you –

- once a year to review your application and circumstances or
- to let you know if you are being considered for the offer of a house.
